

SUNY CPD'S REMOTE TEACHING INSTITUTE RECEIVES AWARD FROM CEANY FOR OUTSTANDING NON-CREDIT PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

We are happy to announce that our Remote Teaching Institute received an award from the <u>Continuing Education Association of New York</u> for Outstanding Non-Credit Program Development. The award was presented earlier this month during the organization's James C. Hall Exemplary Program Awards online ceremony.

The Remote Teaching Institute (RTI) was developed in response to the abrupt move from face to- face instruction to remote instruction in the Spring of 2020. Following a well-received and attended Remote Teaching Clinic that ran in March and April, it was evident that faculty needed a more in-depth professional development opportunity.

The Remote Teaching Institute was designed to help faculty prepare for a Fall 2020 semester that was anticipated to present unique challenges to course design and delivery. Running from June to August 2020, the RTI included a series of workshops on practical course design, followed by asynchronous materials and discussion on instructional design, open educational resources, assessment, learning goals and outcomes, the SUNY Online Course Quality Review Rubric (OSQCR), Innovative Course Design, and Discipline-specific discussions.

The RTI culminated with a series of workshops on flexible instruction strategies. Thank you to the SUNY Online Team and all SUNY Faculty and Staff for contributing their expertise to the RTI. SUNY CPD shares this award with all of you. A special thank you to Jamie Heron, SUNY Online Program Manager, for leading this effort.
